The undersigned is to enclose herewith the copy of the mail received from Ministry of Statistics and Program Implementation, on the subject cited above and is to state that with the approval of the Chairman, CWC, a reply on the assurance was sent to MoSPI dated 31.3.2021(copy enclosed for ready reference) and is reproduced as "**separate Statistical Monitoring and Evaluation Cell across all CWC organization manpowering through Statistical Personnel from ISS/SSS cadre may not be feasible as it involves financial implication for increasing the sanction strength to accommodate additional statistical personnel. CWC is doing the same work since beginning. Instead, we may designate one or two AD/ DD from each field organization and train them through NWA by framing an appropriate module in consultation of Advisor (ISO) for better management data**". In this regard, Action Taken Report are still awaited from NWA, CE(HRM) and Field Offices of CWC.

2. It is, therefore, requested to kindly provide the inputs in this regard by 18.11.2024 so that a suitable reply could be framed and forwarded to MOSPI to fulfil the said assurance.

Kindly refer to your O.M. No. H-11017/01/2020-CAP/RSUQ1723 dated 12.03.2021 on the above cited subject enclosing therewith the Rajya Sabha Un-Starred Question No. 1723 answered by MoSPI on 05.03.2020 regarding 'Implementation of Rangarajan Commission Report'.

2. It was mentioned that the purpose of the question was to seek the status of recommendations pending for implementation. In reply to part (a) and (b) of the question, it was inter-alia stated that out of 623 recommendations, 478 are taken as implemented, 17 are not accepted/dropped, 12 are referred to the National Statistical Commission and 116 recommendations are pending. *This portion of reply has become an assurance for MoSPI.*

3. In this connection, it is to mention that out of 116 pending recommendations, recommendation no. 21 of Chapter 04 of Rangarajan Commission pertains to Central Water Commission and the latest status of the same is enclosed herewith for further necessary action at your end.
